Day 1- Arrive Guyana

Day 2- Historic Georgetown & Lethem

City Tour of Georgetown; Fly to Lethem, Central Rupununi; Afternoon tour of the Guyana/Brazil Frontier; Overnight

Day 3- Dadanawa Ranch-South Rupununi Savannas

Vehicle transfer to Dadanawa; Climb the Totawan Mt for a Panoramic View of the South Rupununi Savannas; Overnight

Day 4-Savannah Trek & Return to Lethem

Early morning Savannah Trek in search of Giant Anteaters; Horse Back Riding & Other Ranch Activities; vehicle transfer Lethem; Overnight

Day 5- Maipaima Lodge, Nappi Amerindian Village

Early morning vehicle transfer to Nappi Village and by Bull Drawn Cart to Maipaima Lodge; Hike to Jordan Falls & Bat Cave; Overnight

Day 6-Caiman House, Yupukari Amerindian Village

Early morning trail walk; Bull Cart & Vehicle transfer to Yupukari Village; Evening Caiman Spotting in the Rupununi River; Overnight

Day 7-Karanambu Lodge

Boat transfer to Karanambu; evening River Tour in search of Giant Otters & witness the opening of the Giant Amazonica Lily; Overnight

Day 8 - Surama Amerindian Village

Early morning Savannah Trek-another opportunity if you miss the Giant Anteater; afternoon boat transfer to Gennip Landing and vehicle transfer to Surama; Trail Walks; Overnight

Day 9- Burro Burro River Tour

Early morning Burro Burro River Tour; Village Tour & Trail Walks; Overnight

Day 10-Rewa Amerindian Village

Early morning vehicle transfer to Kwatamang Landing, Rupununi River; continue by boat to Rewa Lodge; Climb Awaramie Mt; Rewa River Tour; Overnight

Day 11- Rock View Lodge

Early morning River Tour; afternoon boat transfer to Kwatamang Landing; vehicle transfer to Rock View Lodge; Overnight

Day 12- Canopy Walkway & Atta Rainforest Lodge

Afternoon vehicle transfer to Atta Rainforest Lodge; Evening Trail Walks/Canopy Walk; Overnight

Day 13- Iwokrama Rainforest Reserve & River Lodge

Early morning Canopy Walk; Vehicle Transfer Iwokrama Field Station; See the Petro glyphs of the early inhabitants and do some fishing in the Essequibo River; Overnight

Day 14- Amatuk Rainforest Camp

Early morning vehicle transfer to Mahdia onto Potaro River; boat transfer to Amatuk Falls; Overnight Amatuk Rainforest Camp (Hammocks)

Day 15-Waratuk & Kaieteur Falls

Continue by boat/trekking to Waratuk onto Tukeit; commence Hike to Kaieteur Falls; Overnight

Day 16- Transfer to Georgetown

Transfer to Georgetown by aircraft; Overnight
