Other habitats include the Jaguar, Giant Anteater, Giant Otter, Black Caiman, Arapaima and numerous species of Primates, no less than the Red Howler.

Day trip to Kaieteur Falls by Aircraft; Overnight

Day 3- Georgetown to Lethem

City Tour of Georgetown; Aircraft Transfer to Lethem, South Central Rupununi; Overnight

Day 4-5 Maipaima Lodge, Nappi Amerindian Village

Early morning vehicle transfer to Nappi Village; continue by Bull Drawn Cart to Maipaima Lodge; Hike to Jordan Falls & Bat Cave, creatures of the rainforest; Overnight

Day 6-Caiman House, Yupukari Amerindian Village

Vehicle transfer to Yupukari Village; Evening Caiman Spotting; Overnight

Day 7-Karanambu Lodge

Boat Transfer to Karanambu; evening River Tour in search of Giant Otters & Opening Giant Amazonica Lily; Overnight Karanambu Lodge

Day 8 - 9 Surama Amerindian Village

Early morning Savannah Trek in Search of Giant Anteaters; Afternoon boat transfer to Gennip Landing and vehicle transfer to Surama, Village Tour & Nature Walks; Burro Burro River Tour; Overnight

Day 10-11-Rewa Amerindian Village

Early morning vehicle transfer to Kwatamang Landing, Rupununi River; continue by boat to Rewa; Hike to Awaramie Mt; River Tour; Overnight

Day 12- Iwokrama Rainforest Reserve & River Lodge

Early morning boat transfer to Kwatamang Landing; vehicle transfer to Iwokrama Field Station; Evening River Tour; Overnight

Day 13- Turtle Mt & Atta Rainforest Lodge

Early morning hike to Turtle Mt; vehicle transfer to Atta Rainforest Lodge; Evening Trail/Canopy Walks; Overnight

Day 14- Canopy Walk & Rock View Lodge

Early morning Canopy Walk; Vehicle transfer to Rock View Lodge; Overnight

Day 15- Transfer to Georgetown

Transfer to Georgetown by aircraft; Overnight
