The Rupununi is a vast area of dry grassland with sparse trees, termites mounds and wooded hills in the Southwest of the country. The savannah is divided into the North and South Rupununi by the Kanuku Mountains and scattered with occasional Amerindian villages and a few large cattle ranches. Rupununi is an area rich in wildlife, particularly rare and endangered species such as the Black Caiman, Giant Otter, Jaguar. Bird life is rich, particularly in the forest galleries, and the Kanuku Mountains provide a home for the Harpy Eagle. So come enjoy the Rugged Rupununi Trails and more!

Day 1 -Arrival Guyana

Day 2-Kaieteur Falls by aircraft

Day 3-Lethem-Guyana/Brazil Frontier; Fly from Georgetown to Lethem; visit to Kanuku Mts

Day 4- Dadanawa Ranch by 4*4 Vehicle, hike Totawan Mt for panoramic view of the Savannahs

Day 5- Savannah Trek in Search of Giant Anteaters; Ranch Activities with Vaqueros (Local Cowboys) ; vehicle transfer to Lethem

Day 6- Caiman House; Vehicle transfer to Yupukari Amerindian Village; evening Caiman Spotting

Day 7- Surama Amerindian Village; Early morning Rupununi River Tour-Giant Otters and numerous bird species; vehicle transfer to Surama; Village Tour & trail walks

Day 8- Burro Burro River Tour; Visits to the Cock of the Rock & Harpy Eagle Sites

Day 9-Vehicle Transfer to Annai for Flight to Georgetown
